## Erosion Control Plan Review Fee Schedule

### **Small General Projects** (less than 1 acre disturbance)

Fee = \$75.00 (such as culvert installation, and minor re-grading)

### **Linear Projects** (highway, pipeline)

Fee = \$400.00/Linear mile

(Prorated and rounded off to the nearest 1/10 mile)

### **Single Lot Residential Construction**

\$250 Base Fee\*\* + \$150

### **Residential Development** (2+ Lots)

\$750 Base Fee\*\* + \$150.00/Lot

### **Commercial/Industrial Land Development** (including apartment complexes, townhouses, and agricultural construction)

\$250 Base Fee\*\* + \$250.00/disturbed acre (rounded to the nearest whole acre)

### **Corrective Action Plan (CAP)- Erosion and Sediment Control Plan Review Fee**

\$450.00/disturbed acre (rounded to the nearest whole acre)

**\*\* Base fee is ONLY required for NPDES Permit Projects\*\***

## EROSION AND SEDIMENTATION CONTROL PLAN REVIEW FOR TIMBER HARVESTING FEE SCHEDULE\*

\$2.00 per project acre **OR** \$20.00 per earth disturbance acreage, whichever is greater

\* Note: Timber harvesting operations that will disturb 25 or more acres require a permit from DEP (the earth disturbance area is the total area of haul roads, landings, and skid trails). Inquiries as to whether or not a permit is required should be addressed to the Perry County Conservation District or DEP South Central Regional Office.

## **NPDES permits**

The NPDES permit for stormwater discharge from construction activities is required for all earthmoving construction activities of 1 acre or greater of earth disturbance over the lifetime of the project.

If a project to be permitted is located in an Exceptional Value (EV) or High Quality (HQ) watershed an Individual NPDES Permit is required, otherwise a General NPDES Permit is required.

To apply for permit coverage an NOI (Notice of Intent) and accompanying documentation should be submitted with the Erosion Control Plan. The NOI can be found at [www.depweb.state.pa.us](http://www.depweb.state.pa.us) under "keyword" STORMWATER along with instructions, completeness checklists, technical program manuals and State training events for the regulated community.
