

RECYCLING OPTIONS

The following list details where Perry County residents can take hard to recycle items such as used oil, old computer electronics, used batteries, spent CFLs, mercury containing devices, and tires to be recycled.

Computers and Computer Peripherals

Goodwill: Computers, monitors, printers, scanners, and computer peripherals.

Compact Fluorescent Light bulbs (CFLS)

Conservation District Office: Accepts only compact bulbs. Bring to 8 South Carlisle Street, New Bloomfield while program funding lasts. 717-582-5139/717-582-8988 x4.

Used Oil

Local garage: Many local garages accept clean used oil. Call to verify.

Blain Tire and Auto: Blain 717-536-3318. Accepts used motor oil, brake and transmission oil.

Maguires Ford: 79 Main Street, Duncannon, 717-834-3111. Accepts used motor oil, brake and transmission oil.

Rohrer Bus Service: 1515 State Road, Duncannon 717-957-4774. Accepts motor oil.

Smith's Farm Equipment: 30 Auker Road, Newport 717-567-3562. Accepts used motor oil, brake and transmission oil, and antifreeze (keep separate from oils).

Smith's Tire and Service Center: Route 34, Newport, 717-567-3709. Accepts used oil and vegetable oil. Oil must be free of debris and water.
